I eat the eggs of birds and small mammals. I am sneaky and quiet so that the parents don't notice me getting close to their nest.

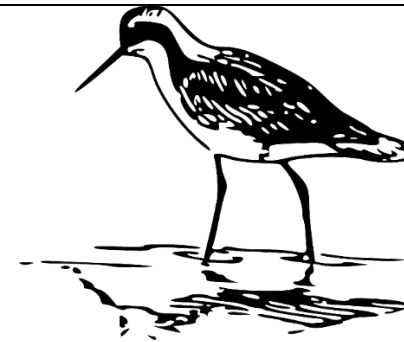

Wilson's Phalarope

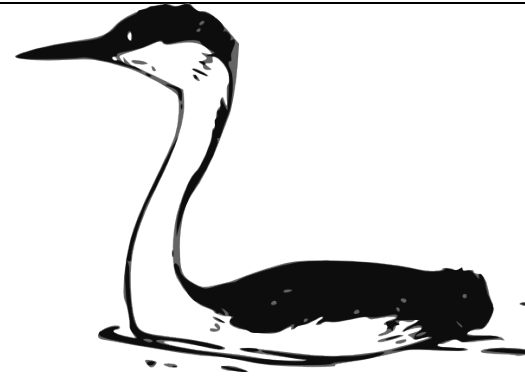
I eat brine flies and brine shrimp. I fly very long distances to get to the Great Salt Lake and can change direction very quickly in flight.

I am a secondary consumer



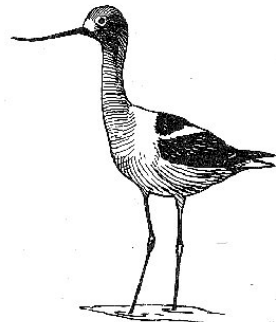
Snowy Plover

I am a secondary consumer.



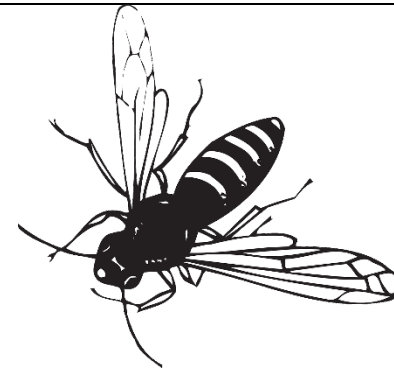
Eared Grebe

I am a secondary consumer.



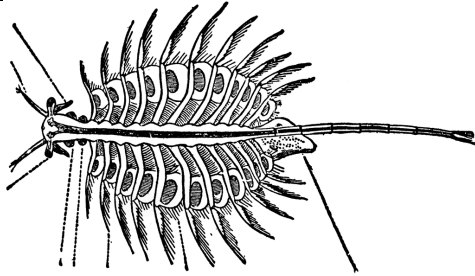
American Avocet

I am a secondary consumer.



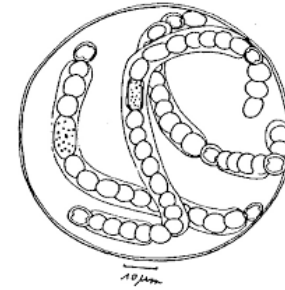
Brine Fly

I am a primary consumer.



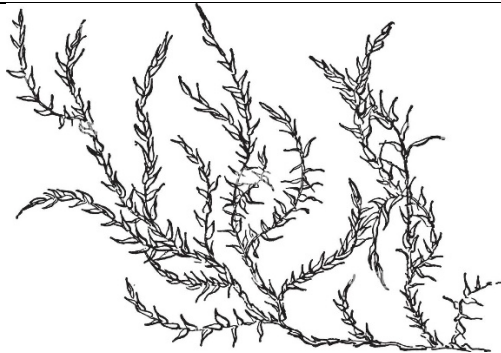
Brine Shrimp

I am a producer.



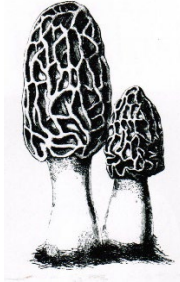
Algae

Fungi

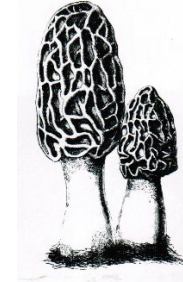
I break down dead organisms into their nutrients and return them to the water of the Great Salt Lake. I can grow very quickly and come in many different shapes and sizes.
